Bid Deadline: Sealed bids must be received on or before **Wednesday, February 25, 2009 at 3:00 PM.**

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Bid shall accompany each Bid. The surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the Bid Deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120).

To be eligible for consideration for award, bidders must have the minimum experience set forth in the Supplementary Instructions to Bidders. Minimum experience will consist of three (3) completed jobs exceeding \$100,000.00 within the past three (3) years on public works, as either a prime contractor or a subcontractor. Bidders must submit qualifications on Bid Form Attachment "A", with their Bid Forms.

A mandatory Pre-Bid Conference and mandatory Pre-Bid Job Walk will be conducted on **Wednesday, February 11, 2009** beginning promptly at **1:30 PM**. Participants shall meet at the Office of Physical Planning and Construction, 1156 High Street, Barn G, Contracts Trailer Santa Cruz Campus. Only bidders who participate in both the Conference and the Job Walk in their entirety, will be allowed to bid on the Project as prime contractors. The successful Bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage rates at the location of the work.

The successful Bidder will be required to have the following California current and active contractor's license at the time of submission of the Bid: **C36 – Plumbing Contractor.**
